You must not confuse the material ownership of a work or a digital file containing the image of this work with the copyrights that are invested in the artist or his/her beneficiaries. If the work you want to reproduce belongs to the catalogue managed by Adagp, then you have [to apply to Adagp](#) [1] who will handle your reproduction request.

Royalties will be paid for this use to Adagp, as with all other uses.
