

The search notice allows you to access the list of works for which one or more rightsholders could not be identified or located. This search notice is made available to you in accordance with Article L. 324-14 of the French Intellectual Property Code.

With this tool, you can check whether rights have been collected or could be collected for you or for an artist you know. If this is the case, [contact us](#) ^[1] so that we can, after studying the supporting documents, pay you the royalties due to you or identify and locate the artist concerned or their rightsholders.

Please note: some of the information available in the search notice relates to sums that have not been collected yet but which may be claimed by the ADAGP or the artist for a period of **five years**, in particular in respect of resale rights.

The amounts of the royalties at stake cannot be communicated before the identity of the author or their rightsholders has been verified by the ADAGP.
