

The intellectual property code

The main acts on copyright (act of 11 March 1957, act of 3 July 1985) were collated (“codified”) in 1992 in the intellectual property code, which currently includes all the legislation and regulations governing copyright: definition of protected works, who holds the rights, content of non-pecuniary and property rights, duration of protection, agreements, collective rights, operation of royalty collecting and distribution societies...

The articles of association and general rules
